Dress	Green and white checked school summer dress with logo
Jumper	School bottle green jumper with school colours
Cardigan	School bottle green cardigan with school colours
Fleece	Reversible school fleece
Socks	Plain white ankle socks with no frills or colours
Shoes	<u>Plain</u> black leather shoes (not lace up), polishable. No trainers/heels/lights/open sides
Raincoat	Lightweight bottle green shower coat (optional - but no other raincoat permitted)
Summer Cap	School cap with removable neck protection (optional - but no other cap permitted)
