Welcome back to you all and I hope you had a wonderful, festive break with family and friends. Thank you very much for the lovely Christmas cards and gifts you and your children gave me and the rest of the staff at the end of term.

We have another busy Spring term ahead so please do regularly check our website and your portal/group call for information. Where sports events are listed in the date list you will be notified separately if your child is taking part.

This term we begin our class assemblies and other events which parents will be invited to attend. Parents Evenings will take place during March. Our 'Drop-in' sessions for parents to informally view their children's work, will also continue during this half term.

The Spring term sees some of our pupils, particularly in Year 6, take their final entrance examinations to a number of independent secondary schools. I know you join me and the Oaklands staff in wishing them all the very best of luck in these exams.

OPA/Christmas

I would like to, once again, thank the OPA for funding some of the wonderful Christmas events for the children.

My thanks to the OPA committee, class representatives and parent volunteers who gave up their time to wrap Santa gifts and supervise the film in the final week of term, great fun was had by all. Our amazing Grotto was constructed by our wonderful volunteers just in time for a visit from the real Santa Claus.

The pantomimes were a great success, with EYFS entertained by Out of the Box productions in the school hall and KS 1 and KS2 going to the Millfield Theatre.

Christmas lunch, with crackers and party hats, was amazing on the last Wednesday of term; thank you to Adam, our chef, and his team in the kitchen.

We ended our Christmas festivities with a whole school assembly, singing carols, playing instruments and celebrating with our Merit awards together with the awarding of our Sports and Science badges. We also celebrated the numerous sporting achievements we have had this term with Mr Paine.

Curriculum Overviews and Timetables

The Curriculum overviews for each age group are published on your parent portals every term. They provide you with detailed information about the teaching content in each subject. I hope you will continue to find them useful documents to refer to during 2025.

We also publish current timetables for each age group to help ensure that each child wears their PE kit to school on the correct day/s of the school week. Key Stage 2 parents please note the changes to year groups who will swim after February half term. We will write with more detail in due course.

Charities

The children were incredibly busy in their charity work last term. We began with generous gifts of tinned food and toiletries filling the school stage at Harvest in October, which were thankfully received by the Whitechapel Mission. The School raised £195 on 'Comfy Clothes' Day for Place2Be, £264 for Children in Need and £268 for Little Princess Trust on Funky Hair Day.

Our Christmas Jumper event raised £192 for Crisis at Christmas and our Carol Service raised £413 for Epping Forest Foodbank. Thank you for your generous donations!

Collection at the end of school

Please ensure you notify the school office before the end of the day if someone different is collecting your child. All children have a password and you should share this only with trusted adults you are sending to collect your child. Please remember to book your child into teatime club in good time, should you need this facility, please do not assume we have space at the end of the day.

School Uniform

All children should be wearing the correct school uniform, including the school scarf, hat and gloves. All items of school clothing and PE kit should be clearly labelled. Please can I remind you that only regulation green tights should be worn under pinafores, no leggings please. Blazers must be worn every day and at this time of year, children must wear their winter coat to school every day as they will be going out to play, except in adverse weather conditions.

Snow

This is usually the term when the weather turns extremely cold and brings us snow. Our maintenance team work hard to make the school paths, steps and entrances clear and safe for use in the event of snow. Please check the website for updates and announcements in the event of heavy snow. We also aim to text parents by 7.15am to provide up to date information about the condition of the roads surrounding the school and the organisation of the school day ahead.

'Drop-in' sessions

The 'Drop-in Sessions' that we held during the Autumn Term continue to be very popular and I received many positive comments about them. The children enjoyed showing off their work and I know many of you found them useful too.

PSHE Jigsaw Scheme of Work

During this half term, pupils will be exploring, at an age appropriate level, the topic of 'Dreams and Goals' which includes:

Parking

Please continue to park legally and considerately when collecting and dropping off your children to school. It is never acceptable to inconvenience our neighbours and bring Oaklands School into disrepute in the local area.

Air Tags and other Tracking devices

In line with many other schools I wish to make you aware that as the use of tracking devices such as Air tags has become more popular, these are NOT designed for tracking the whereabouts of children and should never be used to track a child or be worn at any school event. Airtags are an extremely dangerous device when used incorrectly and actually compromise the safety of others. They are also an intrusion and a breach of privacy, infringing on human rights. It is most definitely unwanted tracking on a school trip, we do not allow the children to carry any Bluetooth connectable devices of any kind on school trips as they compromise the safety of the whole group. We communicate with parents when children arrive at their specified destination and if there are delays on their return journey. It can be very unhelpful if parents tracking their children contradict our communications with parents.
