Re: March 2025 Headmistress's Letter

We now only have a few weeks remaining of our Spring term. Children throughout the school are working hard and enjoying their learning, although I suspect they are now ready for the warmer weather to return. The children who have brought wellies to school will begin to return to playtime on the fields now the worst of the weather has passed.

11+ Entrance Examinations

For our Year 6 pupils and parents, January and February have been rather nerve wracking. From the beginning of the Summer Term of Year 5 through to the Autumn Term of Year 6, the pupils have been working particularly hard preparing for their entrance examinations to a variety of different independent schools. They persevered to complete numerous practice papers, tackling complex sample questions and revisiting areas where they were not 100% secure.

I am delighted to inform you that our pupils have again done extremely well and have all been awarded places at a variety of schools. Many are in the enviable position of having some difficult choices to make as they received a number of offers. The staff and I are extremely proud of them all for their consistent hard work, but also for their caring and supportive attitude towards each other.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the staff for the excellent standard of teaching they enthusiastically and consistently provide to the pupils and the outstanding pastoral care that surrounds every child and helps maintain the 'family' atmosphere of our school.

Parents' Evenings

Our second parents' evenings of the year, for Years 1-6, will take place on Wednesday 26 and Thursday 27 March. The specialist teaching staff will be available on Wednesday 26 only and there will be more details on booking arrangements soon. If you are a Reception parent requiring feedback from specialist teachers please feel free to contact them by email and they will be more than happy to provide a brief, written update for you. Reception parents' evenings take place on Wednesday 19 and Thursday 20 March to avoid clashes with our Mother's Day celebrations.

Parking

We continue to receive numerous complaints every week from our neighbours in Albion Hill, usually with photographs of offending vehicles. Once again, I remind you that blocking drives, even if it is a few feet and for a few minutes, is not acceptable. It makes it very difficult for people to enter and exit their properties on a narrow road. I would urge you, when attending assemblies and other school events, to park elsewhere. Once again, may I remind you not to engage rudely with neighbours who ask you not to obstruct their properties. I am aware there are some spaces on Albion Hill where it is legal to park, I ask you to consider whether you are churning a grass verge or creating a blind spot on an already dangerous road before you leave your vehicle. I am sure you will all agree school staff time is better spent with the pupils rather than calming disgruntled neighbours.

Open Morning

Our second Open Morning of the academic year takes place on Thursday 6 March, 9.15am to 11.15am. You are welcome to come to this event. Prospective and current parents will have the opportunity to see the school at work and to hear more about what is happening at Oaklands. Refreshments will be available in the school hall from 9.00am. I shall be giving a short talk at 9.30am with tours, conducted by our Year 5 and Year 6 pupils, commencing at 9.45am. Our older pupils are always happy and confident to talk about life at Oaklands from a pupil's perspective.

Uniform

A reminder that children should be in full school uniform, with blazers, unless they have PE. Please do not send children wearing any neckwear other than our school scarf. Unless in PE kit, children must wear smart, black shoes for school and a letter, stating reasons, is needed if your child is not wearing shoes.

Manipulative Marketing in Mobile Games - Better Internet for Kids

Finally, I have attached some wording and a link for you all to read concerning marketing in Mobile Games, some of which our children are often exposed to. Children are increasingly becoming major components in the online games industry. Many games are deceptively pay to play, whilst claiming to be free. For most of these apps the download is free but most of the gameplay is locked. 'Free' in the context of apps is a highly flexible term. Online gaming firms use the 'free' label to draw in players, whom when talking about minors may be attractive due solely to that quality. Money making tactics such as these can be hard to detect even for adults. Their use of bright colours, distracting music and other methods can be highly persuasive in gaining players. Better Internet for Kids has crafted a learning module designed to explore digital marketing tactics. You will learn why companies use these tactics and how they can impact your child and their rights. You will also learn how you can support your child to spot and avoid these issues, as well as where you can seek help and support.
